## **BUILDING HISTORY**

Constructed of locally-made brick on the original site of the Nacogdoches County Courthouse. The Mahdeen Company, which operated from 1912 to 1985 occupied the basement and the third floor, which housed the vats for mixing and bottling hair tonic. The first and second floor of this building were used by auto dealerships such as Duke H. Herbert Ford Co, and Ben T. Wilson Chevrolet. The building was later used by Village Furniture Store, Wyatt's Office City and Story-Wright Office Supply.
